
How to Read the Detail Table For Capital Projects

This detail table provides information on all the Governor's proposals for the capital budget. Agencies are displayed by secretarial area, in the same order as in the Budget Bill. The table shows only those secretarial areas and agencies

for which the Governor's proposed amendments to the 2002-2004 biennial budget includes a capital recommendation. Figures are whole dollar amounts. Negative numbers appear with a minus sign.



Notes to these tables

- **1.** Line 1 is the secretarial area.
- **2.** Line 2 is the agency.
- **3.** Line 3 shows each capital project recommended for the agency in the Governor's proposed amendments to the 2002-2004 biennial budget.
- **4.** Line 4 is the total recommended for the agency for capital projects in the Gov-
- ernor's proposed amendments to the 2002-2004 biennial budget (i.e., the total of all individual capital projects in Line 3).
- **5.** Line 5 shows the total recommended for capital projects for the secretarial area.
