## **Description of Agency or Boards**

The Board of Local and Regional Jails (BLRJ) is established in the Code of Virginia §53.1-2 et seq. The BLRJ is authorized to: establish operational and fiscal standards governing the operation of local and regional correctional facilities; establish minimum standards for health care services in local, regional, and community correctional facilities and procedures for enforcing such minimum standards; develop and implement policies and procedures for the review of the death of any inmate that the board determines warrants review that occurs in any local, regional, or community correctional facility; establish minimum standards for the construction, equipment, administration, and operation of local correctional facilities and lockups.
