Virginia adopted the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) recommended aluminum criteria into the Water Quality Standards regulation, effective June 2024. These criteria are to be integrated into requirements for the issuance of certain Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (VPDES) permits in the Commonwealth. The VPDES permit program and the water quality monitoring and assessment programs are the primary programs which will be charged with implementing the criteria once effective. Water quality assessment procedures are established every two years coinciding with development and publication of the biennial Water Quality Assessment 305(b)/303(d) Integrated Report (IR).
