The Department of General Services, Division of Laboratory Services (DCLS) accredits			
environmental laboratories under §2.2-1105 of the Code of Virginia. Subsection 2.2-1105 C			
requires DCLS to establish a fee system to offset the costs of this program. 1VAC30-45-130 and			
1VAC30-46-150 set out the required fees. These fees, effective April 1, 2022, no longer offset the			
costs of the program and need to be revised. The Commonwealth's Budget (Chapter 725, Item			
68 C 3a) exempts from the Administrative Process Act "any regulations necessary to change the			
amount of the fees charged [under this program] provided that input is solicited from the public.			
Such input requires only that notice and an opportunity to submit written comments be given.".
